## ACTIVELY AFFIRMING THE HUMAN DIGNITY OF TRANSGENDER AND NONBINARY PERSONS

## **A Resolution of Witness**

## 1 **TEXT OF THE MOTION**

2 3 **WHEREAS** the United Church of Christ has staked its claim to be an open and affirming denomination<sup>1</sup> and has worked hard to maintain a radical welcome to the LGBTO+ community 4 in many of our churches<sup>2</sup>; and 5 6 7 **WHEREAS** the human dignity and human rights of transgender and non-binary people are 8 being threatened in at least 30 states through legislation that denies access to life-saving health 9 care, participation in sports, and utilization of gender appropriate bathrooms<sup>3</sup>; and 10 WHEREAS gender dysphoria is a serious medical condition that, if left untreated, can result in 11 severe anxiety and depression, self-harm, and suicidality<sup>4</sup>; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS when appropriately treated, gender dysphoria is easily managed by following 15 appropriate treatment protocols to affirm their gender identity and alleviate distress<sup>5</sup>; and 16 WHEREAS compassionate parents and medical teams are, in some states, being legally 17 punished for offering, providing, and extending life-saving healthcare to trans and nonbinary 18 19 vouth and adults<sup>6</sup>; and 20 21 WHEREAS decisions about gender-affirming medical care must be made between a provider, 22 patient, and the patient's parents or guardians<sup>7</sup>; and 23 24 WHEREAS trans and nonbinary youth and adults face a higher rate of death by suicide than 25 their peers and are more vulnerable to violence and death, specifically and disproportionately transgender women of color<sup>8</sup>; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS a Gay, Lesbian & Straight Education Network (GLSEN) survey shows that more 29 than 80% of "gender expansive" students have been harassed and a third feel unsafe in classrooms<sup>9</sup>: and 30 31 32 WHEREAS research shows that it can be extremely harmful for a transgender person to be 33 excluded from a sports team consistent with their gender identity;<sup>10</sup> and 34 35 WHEREAS in a country where transgender people have no federal protections while they face massive discrimination and attacks, civil rights must be spelled out and protected<sup>11</sup>; and 36 37 38 **WHEREAS** public discourse perpetuating the myth of the gender binary causes great harm when used as the rationale for discrimination and punitive legislation;<sup>12</sup> and 39

- 41 **WHEREAS** efforts of allies sometimes fail to provide the support intended for our transgender 42 and non-binary siblings, including UCC Open and Affirming congregations<sup>13</sup>;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Thirty-Fourth General Synod of the United Church
  of Christ reaffirms the historic commitment of this church to recognize and affirm that every
  human being is created in the image of God and is due respect for their <u>inherent</u> human dignity

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Thirty-Fourth General Synod of the United Church of
 Christ reaffirms and proclaims and affirm people of transgender, and non-binary, and gender
 diverse experiences are beloved by God, with unique gifts and graces from the Divine for the life

- love and treat with worth and dignity; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Thirty-Fourth General Synod of the United Church of Christ encourages all settings of the church, working with local partners, to promote advocate for the full legal equality at every level of law that protects the rights of transgender, nonbinary, and gender non-conformingdiverse persons; and

- 61 Christ re-affirm our commitmentencourages all settings of the church to lift upamplify the

- nonbinary, and gender non-conformingdiverse persons against\_the harm done, often through the

   66 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Thirty-Fourth General Synod of the United Church of
   67 Christ encourages all settings of the church to organize to provide aid, comfort, and sanctuary to
- 68 all who have been made refugees by hostile legislation; and

- 70 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Thirty-Fourth General Synod of the United Church of 71 Christ calls on the leadership and other appropriate ministries of the United Church of Christ in

- 73 opportunities to help to learn how to affirm and inform congregations, communities, policy-

- FUNDING: The funding the implementation of this resolution will be made in accordance with the overall mandates of the affected agencies and the funds available.

- **IMPLEMENTATION:** The Officers of the Church, in consultation with appropriate ministries
- or other entities with the United Church of Christ, will determine the implementing body.
